## CHAPTER 625

(Senate Bill 797)

AN ACT concerning

**Property and Casualty Insurers - Geographic Distribution of Private Passenger and Residential Property Premium - Major Insurer - Definition - Filing Data by Bulletin**

FOR the purpose of repealing altering a certain definition certain provisions of law requiring certain authorized insurers and the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund to file with the Insurance Commissioner in a certain manner certain data about the geographic distribution of private passenger premium and residential property premium; repealing altering certain provisions of law requiring certain major insurers to file a certain marketing plan with the Commissioner in a certain manner; requiring certain authorized insurers and the Maryland Automobile Insurance Fund to file with the Commissioner in a certain manner by bulletin certain data about the geographic distribution of private passenger premium and residential property premium repealing certain obsolete reporting requirements; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to filing data about the geographic distribution of private passenger and residential property premium under property and casualty insurance.
