- [(c)] (E) A person may not dump, deposit, scatter, or release sewage sludge by any means, including discharge from a sewer or pipe, into or onto any portion of the water or bottomland of the Chesapeake Bay or of the tidewater portions of any of the Chesapeake Bay's tributaries within 5 miles of the Hart-Miller-Pleasure Island chain in Baltimore County.
- [(d)](F) A person may not [dump, deposit, or scatter any earth, rock, soil, waste matter, muck,] REDEPOSIT DREDGED MATERIAL or other material excavated or dredged from the Chesapeake Bay or its tidal tributaries into or onto the area of the bottomlands or waters of the Chesapeake Bay known as the deep trough.

 - (B) (1) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL CONSIST OF:

- $\underline{(2)}$ $\underline{(II)}$ THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL RESOURCES, OR THE SECRETARYS DESIGNEE;
- (3) (III) THE SECRETARY OF THE ENVIRONMENT, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
- (4) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ARMY CORPS OF ENCINEERS, PHILADELPHIA DISTRICT;
- (5) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ARMY CORPS OF ENCINEERS, BALTIMORE DISTRICT;
- (6) (IV) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CHESAPEAKE BAY FOUNDATION, DESIGNATED BY THE CHESAPEAKE BAY FOUNDATION:
- (7) (V) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF THE DREDGED MATERIAL PLACEMENT PROGRAM; AND
 - (8) (VI) A CITIZEN REPRESENTATIVE, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
- (2) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INVITE THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE TO SERVE AS MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:
- (I) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, PHILADELPHIA DISTRICT; AND
- (II) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, BALTIMORE DISTRICT.
- (C) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL MEET AS NEEDED, BUT NOT LESS THAN SEMIANNUALLY.
