(2) TO RECEIVE A DISCOUNTED MARRIAGE LICENSE FEE UNDER THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL VERIFY COMPLETION OF A PREMARITAL PREPARATION COURSE BY FILING WITH THE CLERK A VALID CERTIFICATE OF COURSE COMPLETION ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(F) ANY COST FOR A PREMARITAL PREPARATION COURSE SHALL BE PAID BY THE APPLICANT FOR A MARRIAGE LICENSE.

(G) THE DISCOUNT AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE APPLIED TO ANY FEE USED TO FUND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

(House Bill 66)

AN ACT concerning

Fire Safety— Smoke Detectors – Residential Dwelling Units Disclosure

FOR the purpose of requiring that ~~smoke detectors of a certain type be used in a residential dwelling unit that is sold or rented or in which renovations requiring a building permit or electrical permit are performed; making this Act applicable to smoke detectors powered in a certain way~~ certain leases and contracts of sale residential property disclosure statements include a certain disclosure relating to smoke detectors; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to disclosures in leases and contracts of sale residential property disclosure statements regarding smoke detectors.
