

(i) admission to a nightclub or room in a hotel, restaurant, hall, or other place where dancing privileges, music, or other entertainment is provided; or

(ii) merchandise, refreshment, or a service sold or served in connection with entertainment at a nightclub or room in a hotel, restaurant, hall, or other place where dancing privileges, music, or other entertainment is provided; AND

(6) HARFORD COUNTY ON GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM:

(I) ANY ADMISSIONS AND AMUSEMENT CHARGE FOR GOLF ENTERTAINMENT; OR

(II) ANY ADMISSIONS AND AMUSEMENT CHARGE IN CONNECTION WITH A BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES DRIVE-IN MOVIE ENTERTAINMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 648

(House Bill 213)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - ~~Liquor~~ Powers of Inspectors

FOR the purpose of ~~providing that the Harford County Liquor Control Board shall specify the duties of the liquor inspectors; granting to liquor inspectors in Harford County all the powers of a peace officer, constable, or sheriff in the State with respect to the enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws in the county; requiring liquor inspectors in Harford County to take a certain oath; and generally relating to liquor inspectors~~ authorizing inspectors in Harford County who investigate violations of alcoholic beverages licenses to issue civil citations under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the powers of inspectors of alcoholic beverages alcoholic beverages inspectors in Harford County.
