

(2) WHO HAS BEEN FOUND GUILTY OF A CRIME, EVEN IF THE DEFENDANT HAS BEEN FOUND NOT CRIMINALLY RESPONSIBLE; OR

(3) WHOSE PLEA OF NOLO CONTENDERE TO A CRIME HAS BEEN ACCEPTED BY THE COURT.

(F) DIVISION.

"DIVISION" MEANS THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION.

(G) JUDGMENT OF RESTITUTION.

"JUDGMENT OF RESTITUTION" MEANS A DIRECT ORDER FOR PAYMENT OF RESTITUTION OR AN ORDER FOR PAYMENT OF RESTITUTION THAT IS A CONDITION OF PROBATION IN AN ORDER OF PROBATION.

(H) LIABLE PARENT.

"LIABLE PARENT" MEANS A PARENT:

(1) WHOSE CHILD HAS COMMITTED A CRIME OR DELINQUENT ACT; AND

(2) WHO HAS BEEN ORDERED TO PAY RESTITUTION UNDER § 11-604 OF THIS TITLE.

In item (1) of this subsection, the defined term "delinquent act" is added for clarity. See General Revisor's Note to this title.

(I) RESTITUTION OBLIGOR.

"RESTITUTION OBLIGOR" MEANS A DEFENDANT, CHILD RESPONDENT, OR LIABLE PARENT AGAINST WHOM A JUDGMENT OF RESTITUTION HAS BEEN ENTERED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid repetition of the phrase "defendant, child respondent, or liable parent".
