AN ACT concerning

On-Site Generated Electricity - Exemption Approval Process

FOR the purpose of ~~exempting certain generating stations that produce only on-site generated electricity from the requirement to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity for certain purposes~~ requiring the Public Service Commission to waive the requirement to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity under certain circumstances; requiring the Commission to require a person to obtain approval from the Commission before the person may construct a generating station under certain circumstances; requiring an application to contain certain information; requiring the Commission to consider certain criteria, require certain notification, and conduct its review and approval in a certain manner; authorizing the Commission to waive an element of a certain process under certain
