SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 28 - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

~~THE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR THE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY NOT APPROVE A SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO CONSTRUCT OR OPERATE A RUBBLE LANDFILL AT A SITE WITHOUT A THREE-FOURTHS MAJORITY VOTE OF THE DISTRICT COUNCIL, IF:~~

~~(1) AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO CONSTRUCT OR OPERATE A RUBBLE LANDFILL AT THE SITE WAS PREVIOUSLY DENIED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1981; OR~~

~~(2) THE SITE IS LOCATED IN A ZONE THAT ALLOWS RESIDENTIAL USE AT A DENSITY OF AT LEAST TWO RESIDENTIAL UNITS PER ACRE.~~

THE DISTRICT COUNCIL OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY MAY NOT APPROVE A SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO CONSTRUCT OR OPERATE A RUBBLE LANDFILL AT A SITE WITHOUT A THREE-FOURTHS MAJORITY VOTE OF THE DISTRICT COUNCIL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ June 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 687

(House Bill 829)

AN ACT concerning

Advisory Council on Offender Employment Coordination

FOR the purpose of establishing an Advisory Council on Offender Employment Coordination in the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services; providing for the membership, chairman, staff, and executive director of the Council; requiring the Council to gather information, solicit ideas, and advise and provide guidance to the executive director on certain matters; requiring that certain governmental personnel shall cooperate with the Council with regard to reasonable requests for information from the Council; requiring certain reports;
