- (2) IF A VACANCY OCCURS DURING THE TERM OF A MEMBER, THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY SHALL APPOINT ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM.
  - (D) A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL:
- $_{(1)}$   $\,$  MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR DUTIES PERFORMED AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
- (E) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL PROVIDE:
  - (1) A FULL-TIME EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR; AND
  - (2) STAFF SUPPORT AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

- (A) (1) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE COUNCIL SHALL PREPARE A BUDGET FOR SUBMISSION TO THE GOVERNOR WITH DUE RECARD TO THE DICTATES OF PRACTICALITY AND THE FISCAL CONDITION OF THE STATE.
- (2) THE COVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE COUNCIL IN THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET SUFFICIENT FOR THE OPERATION OF THE COUNCIL.
- (B) THE COUNCIL IS SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY THE OFFICE OF THE LECISLATIVE AUDITOR IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 2 1217 THROUGH 2 1227 OF THE STATE COVERNMENT ARTICLE.

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## THE COUNCIL SHALL:

- (1) GATHER INFORMATION, SOLICIT IDEAS, AND ADVISE AND PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ON WAYS TO:
- (I) DEVELOP TRANSITIONAL SUPPORTS AND EXPAND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR OFFENDERS BOTH IN INSTITUTIONAL AND COMMUNITY SETTINGS;
- (II) PROVIDE MORE EXTENSIVE EMPLOYMENT COUNSELING FOR OFFENDERS UNDER CORRECTIONAL CONTROL;
- (III) TRANSFER SUCCESSFUL INSTITUTIONAL PROGRAMS AND SERVICES THAT PREPARE OFFENDERS FOR EMPLOYMENT AND PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES TO COMMUNITY SETTINGS;
- (IV) INCREASE JOB PLACEMENT AND JOB RETENTION RATES FOR ALL OFFENDERS UNDER CORRECTIONAL CONTROL;
