ALL PERSONNEL IN ANY GOVERNMENTAL UNIT SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE COUNCIL IN THE DISCHARGE OF THE FUNCTIONS OF THE COUNCIL AND WITH REGARD TO ANY REASONABLE REQUEST THAT THE COUNCIL MAKES FOR INFORMATION ASSOCIATED WITH ITS DUTIES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31, 2001 AND EACH OCTOBER 31 THEREAFTER, THE COUNCIL SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT CONCERNING ITS ACTIVITIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and 3 months and, at the end of August 31, 2004, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
