

(II) ON RECEIPT OF A LICENSE FEE SET BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT.

(2) ON PAYMENT OF THE LICENSE FEE, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(N) (1) WHILE AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ERECT, CONSTRUCT, WIRE, ALTER, REPLACE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR, DISMANTLE, OR SERVICE ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS, AND MOVING WALKS UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR

(2) WHILE AN ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR LICENSE IS IN EFFECT, IT AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF ERECTING, CONSTRUCTING, WIRING, ALTERING, REPLACING, MAINTAINING, REPAIRING, DISMANTLING, OR SERVICING ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS, AND MOVING WALKS.

(O) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 2-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, A LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE SECOND ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE.

(2) THE SECRETARY OF LABOR, LICENSING, AND REGULATION MAY DETERMINE THAT LICENSES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL EXPIRE ON A STAGGERED BASIS.

(3) AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE A LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL MAIL TO THE LICENSEE, AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE:

(I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION FORM; AND

(II) A NOTICE THAT STATES:

1. THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;

2. THE DATE BY WHICH THE BOARD MUST RECEIVE THE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND

3. THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(4) BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW THE LICENSE FOR AN ADDITIONAL 2-YEAR TERM IF THE LICENSEE:

(I) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(II) PAYS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND

(III) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES.

(5) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS:
