BY THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR TO HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE COMBINATION OF DOCUMENTED EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION TO PERFORM ELEVATOR WORK WITHOUT DIRECT AND IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION.

- (3) ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED BY A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR TO HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE COMBINATION OF DOCUMENTED EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION TO PERFORM ELEVATOR WORK WITHOUT DIRECT AND IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION SHALL IMMEDIATELY SEEK A TEMPORARY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE FROM THE BOARD AND SHALL PAY THE FEE THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.
- (4) EACH TEMPORARY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE IS VALID FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS WHILE THE LICENSEE IS EMPLOYED BY THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR THAT CERTIFIED THE LICENSEE AS QUALIFIED.
- (5) A TEMPORARY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE MAY BE RENEWED AS LONG AS THE SHORTAGE OF LICENSE HOLDERS CONTINUES.
- (R) (1) SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (S) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY DENY A LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT, REFUSE TO RENEW A LICENSE, REPRIMAND A LICENSEE, SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE, OR IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000 IF THE BOARD FINDS THAT THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE:

- $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ $\frac{(III)}{(2)}$ VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR § 49B OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- $\underline{\text{(IV)}}$ TRANSFERS THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE LICENSE TO ANOTHER PERSON;
- $\frac{(V)}{INSTALLS, REPAIRS, OR MAINTAINS \ AN \ ELEVATOR \ OR \ ASSISTS}{IN \ THE \ INSTALLATION, REPAIR, OR MAINTENANCE \ OF \ AN \ ELEVATOR \ IN \ A \ NEGLIGENT OR CARELESS MANNER; OR$
- (VI) WILLFULLY OR DELIBERATELY DISREGARDS AND VIOLATES BUILDING CODES, ELECTRICAL CODES, OR CONSTRUCTION LAWS OF THE STATE OR OF ANY COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE.
- (2) IN DETERMINING THE APPROPRIATE PENALTY TO BE IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD SHALL CONSIDER:
 - (I) THE GRAVITY OF THE VIOLATION;
 - (II) THE GOOD FAITH OF THE VIOLATOR;
