[(4)](5) The Sheriff may also appoint a chief deputy and a warden who shall serve at the pleasure of the Sheriff.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "newspaper in general circulation" in provisions of law that refer to publishing a certain legal advertisement or notice to mean include, for certain purposes, in Prince George's County, a newspaper of record and certain other newspapers; and generally relating to altering the definition of "newspaper in general circulation" to mean include, in Prince George's County, a newspaper of record and certain other newspapers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 1 - Rules of Interpretation

28.

- (A) In a law, resolution, or court order or decree that refers to publishing a legal advertisement or legal notice, words such as "paper", "newspaper", "newspaper in general circulation", or "newspaper devoted to the dissemination of general news" mean, unless otherwise provided, a publication that:
 - (1) Has at least 4 pages,
- (2) Habitually contains news items, reports of current events, editorial comments, advertising matter, and other miscellaneous information that is of public interest and is found generally in an ordinary newspaper;
