- (3) May only be requested as described under subsection (b) of this section, required as described under subsection (c) of this section, or directed as described under subsection (d) of this section:
- (i) In the case of a police officer who is a trainee, or who is participating directly or indirectly in a program of training described in paragraph (2) of this subsection, if the police officer is a member of, and is designated as a trainee or a participant by the head of:
- 5. The [Mass] MARYLAND Transit Administration Police Force.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Department of Transportation shall make changes to vehicles, signs, and all other relevant materials necessary as a result of the name change enacted by this Act within existing resources only and without additional expenditures from the Transportation Trust Fund.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the approval of the Executive Director of the Department of Legislative Services, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall propose the correction of references to the Mass Transit Administration that are rendered incorrect by this Act.

SECTION 2. $\underline{4}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, $\underline{2001}$.

CHAPTER 731

(Senate Bill 576)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance Producer Licensing Act

FOR the purpose of requiring an individual to be licensed before that individual may act as an insurance producer in the State; defining the term "insurance producer"; defining and replacing certain terms; repealing provisions relating to the licensing of fraternal benefit agents; establishing educational standards, examination requirements, and other requirements that must be met to be licensed or to have a license renewed, repealing a certain bond requirement; authorizing a business entity to be licensed as an insurance producer if the business entity meets certain requirements; providing for the issuance, scope, term, renewal, and reinstatement of a license; repealing a prohibition on renewing the license of an agent who has not held an appointment for a certain period of time; requiring an insurer that terminates the appointment of an insurance producer to notify the Commissioner of the termination and report certain information to the Commissioner; requiring the Commissioner to grant waivers of certain licensing requirements to nonresidents under certain
