Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 19 – State Highways – Designation – Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

This bill requires the State Highway Administration to designate Maryland Route 43 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

House Bill 38, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 19.

Senate Bill No. 19

AN ACT concerning

State Highways – Designation – Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to designate a certain State highway as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

BY adding to:

Article – Transportation

Section 8-651

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1993 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

8-651.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DESIGNATE MARYLAND ROUTE 43 AS THE KOREAN WAR VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
