

REGISTER IN ANOTHER STATE OR BY A FEDERAL, MILITARY, OR NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL COURT FOR A CRIME THAT OCCURRED BEFORE JULY 1, 1997; OR

(7) A CHILD SEXUAL OFFENDER, OFFENDER, SEXUALLY VIOLENT OFFENDER, OR SEXUALLY VIOLENT PREDATOR WHO IS REQUIRED TO REGISTER IN ANOTHER STATE, WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE, AND WHO ENTERS THIS STATE:

(I) TO CARRY ON EMPLOYMENT OR A VOCATION THAT IS FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME FOR A PERIOD EXCEEDING 14 DAYS OR FOR AN AGGREGATE PERIOD EXCEEDING 30 DAYS DURING A CALENDAR YEAR, WHETHER FINANCIALLY COMPENSATED, VOLUNTARY, OR FOR A GOVERNMENTAL OR EDUCATIONAL BENEFIT; OR

(II) TO ATTEND A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION, INCLUDING A SECONDARY SCHOOL, TRADE OR PROFESSIONAL INSTITUTION, OR INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION, AS A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME STUDENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 792(a)(7) and the introductory language of (c)(1).

This section, which in large part is a revision of a former definition provision, conforms to the format used in other revised articles by stating a licensing or registration requirement in a substantive provision.

In items (5) and (6) of this section, the references to a "crime" are substituted for the former references to an "offense" to conform to the terminology used throughout this article.

11-705. DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION.

(A) "RESIDENT" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "RESIDENT" MEANS A PERSON WHO LIVES IN THIS STATE WHEN THE PERSON:

- (1) IS RELEASED;
- (2) IS GRANTED PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT;
- (3) IS GRANTED PROBATION AFTER JUDGMENT;
- (4) IS GRANTED A SUSPENDED SENTENCE; OR
