- (12) THREE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OFFICIALS FROM RURAL COUNTIES, SELECTED BY THE SECRETARY OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AS FOLLOWS:
  - (I) ONE FROM THE EASTERN SHORE OF MARYLAND;
  - (II) ONE FROM THE WESTERN SHORE OF MARYLAND: AND
  - (III) ONE FROM SOUTHERN MARYLAND; AND
- [(11)] (12) (13) five members appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House to represent each of the following rural industry sectors:
  - (i) agriculture;
  - (ii) forestry;
  - (iii) fisheries;
  - (iv) mineral extraction; and
  - (v) rural commercial finance or lending.
- (c) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall jointly designate two of the members as co-chairs of the Task Force.
  - (d) The Task Force shall:
- (1) examine the need for, and the feasibility of, establishing a financing development authority to assist Maryland's farming, fishing, forestry, and mining extraction industries with loans, financing, training, and technical and business planning assistance services;
- (2) consider the types of loans, financing, training, technical and business planning assistance services, and other programs that a financing development authority should implement;
- (3) consider the amount in which a financing development authority should be funded:
- (4) consider whether the financing development authority should be an independent State government entity or be incorporated into an existing State government agency;
- (5) develop recommendations regarding the establishment of the financing development authority; [and]
- (6) report its PRELIMINARY recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2000; AND
- (7) BASED ON A COMPREHENSIVE INTERAGENCY ASSESSMENT OF THE NEEDS OF AFFECTED INDUSTRIES, INCLUDING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, EXPECTED
