SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### Article 33 - Election Code

#### 4-203.

- (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraph [(2)(i)] (2)(II) of this subsection, in Baltimore County, members of the party central committees may not run at large.
- [(2) (i) Except for the Chairman, the members of the Republican Party Central Committee shall be elected from the legislative districts of Baltimore County as follows:
- 1. Three members shall be elected from any legislative district that comprises 66% or more of its population within Baltimore County;
