

3. THE REGISTRANT HAS BEEN PREVIOUSLY REQUIRED TO REGISTER AND HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A SUBSEQUENT CRIME AS A CHILD SEXUAL OFFENDER OR AN OFFENDER OR HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A SUBSEQUENT SEXUALLY VIOLENT OFFENSE.

(5) A REGISTRANT WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF THE STATE SHALL REGISTER FOR THE APPROPRIATE TIME SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBSECTION OR UNTIL THE REGISTRANT'S EMPLOYMENT OR STUDENT ENROLLMENT IN THE STATE ENDS.

(B) COMPUTATION OF TERMS.

A TERM OF REGISTRATION DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE COMPUTED FROM:

- (1) THE LAST DATE OF RELEASE; OR
- (2) THE DATE GRANTED PROBATION OR A SUSPENDED SENTENCE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 792(d).

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the former references to "probation before judgment" and "probation after judgment" are deleted as included in the reference to "probation". In addition, the former reference to "[t]he date of receiving a sentence that does not include a term of imprisonment" is deleted as included in the reference to "a suspended sentence".

The Criminal Procedure Article Review Committee notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that subsection (b)(2) of this section is unclear as to the starting date of the term of registration: the date granted probation or the date granted a suspended sentence?

11-708. DUTIES OF SUPERVISING AUTHORITY.

(A) AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.

WHEN A REGISTRANT REGISTERS, THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY SHALL:

(1) GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE REGISTRANT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) EXPLAIN THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE TO THE REGISTRANT, INCLUDING:

(I) THE DUTIES OF A REGISTRANT WHEN THE REGISTRANT CHANGES RESIDENCE ADDRESS IN THIS STATE;
