11-712. NOTICE OF ESCAPE AND RECAPTURE.

(A) ESCAPE.

IF A REGISTRANT ESCAPES FROM A CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY OF THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY BY THE MOST REASONABLE AND EXPEDIENT MEANS AVAILABLE SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY:

(1) THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE REGISTRANT RESIDED BEFORE THE REGISTRANT WAS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY; AND

(2) EACH PERSON WHO IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE UNDER § 11-715(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) RECAPTURE.

IF THE REGISTRANT IS RECAPTURED, THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY SHALL SEND NOTICE, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE BUT NOT LATER THAN 2 WORKING DAYS AFTER THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY LEARNS OF THE RECAPTURE, TO:

(1) THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE REGISTRANT RESIDED BEFORE THE REGISTRANT WAS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE SUPERVISING AUTHORITY; AND

(2) EACH PERSON WHO IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE NOTICE UNDER § 11-715(A) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
