- (vi) The Sheriff's office shall also have assistants at the compensation provided for in the annual ordinance of estimates of Baltimore City. Provisions shall also be made in the ordinance for the expenses of the office of the Sheriff, including the purchase and maintenance of motor vehicles.
- (vii) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore have the same power with respect to the salaries of the office of the Sheriff as they have under the city charter with respect to the salaries of all municipal departments.
- (viii) Employees of the Sheriff's office, except the Sheriff, shall be selected according to the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 286 – Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities – Home Detention and Farm Labor Programs.

This bill requires the establishment of a home detention program in Anne Arundel County.

House Bill 521, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 286.

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities - Home Detention and Farm Labor Programs

FOR the purpose of requiring the Administrator of the Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities to establish and administer a home detention program and adopt regulations for the program; restricting which inmates may be eligible for the program; providing that the inmates who participate in the program are responsible for certain expenses and may be required to pay a fee in connection with the program; setting penalties for an
