18. THE MARYLAND PHARMACY ASSOCIATION; AND

- (II) SIX SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC.
- (ii) (3) The number of names on a list shall be 3.
- (iii) Each nominee of the Maryland Hospital Association, Inc., shall:
- 1. [represent] REPRESENT a hospital that provides hypertensive services on an outpatient basis[.];
- 2. SHALL BE THE DIRECTOR OF REHABILITATION AT A HOSPITAL THAT PROVIDES STROKE REHABILITATION SERVICES: OR
- 3. SHALL-BE THE DIRECTOR OF A STROKE CENTER AT A MARYLAND HOSPITAL.
- (3) (4) If a vacancy occurs for a reason other than expiration of the term, the Governor may appoint any individual without the list.
 - (b) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.
- (2) The terms of 16 OF THE members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Advisory Council as of July 1, 1982. [The terms of those members end as follows:
 - (i) 4 in 1983;
 - (ii) 4 in 1984:
 - (iii) 3 in 1985; and
 - (iv) 5 in 1986.]
- (3) THE TERMS OF FOUR EIGHT OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED AS OF JULY 1, 2001.
- [(3)] (4) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- [(4)] (5) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- [(5)] (6) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4-year terms may not be reappointed for 4 years after the completion of those terms.
- $\[\[\] \]$ (7) If a vacancy occurs, the Governor promptly shall appoint a successor.

- (a) The members present at a meeting are a quorum to do business.
- (b) The Advisory Council shall meet at least twice a year, at the times and places that it determines.
