~~3. SHALL BE THE DIRECTOR OF A STROKE CENTER AT A MARYLAND HOSPITAL.~~

(3) (4) If a vacancy occurs for a reason other than expiration of the term, the Governor may appoint any individual without the list.

(b) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.

(2) The terms of 16 OF THE members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Advisory Council as of July 1, 1982. [The terms of those members end as follows:

(i) 4 in 1983;

(ii) 4 in 1984;

(iii) 3 in 1985; and

(iv) 5 in 1986.]

(3) THE TERMS OF ~~FOUR~~ EIGHT OF THE MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED AS OF JULY 1, 2001.

[(3)] (4) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

[(4)] (5) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

[(5)] (6) A member who serves 2 consecutive full 4-year terms may not be reappointed for 4 years after the completion of those terms.

[(6)] (7) If a vacancy occurs, the Governor promptly shall appoint a successor.

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(a) The members present at a meeting are a quorum to do business.

(b) The Advisory Council shall meet at least twice a year, at the times and places that it determines.
