11-721. PROHIBITED ACT; PENALTY.

(A) PROHIBITED ACT.

A REGISTRANT MAY NOT KNOWINGLY FAIL TO REGISTER OR KNOWINGLY PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION OF A MATERIAL FACT AS REQUIRED BY THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) PENALTY.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$5,000 OR BOTH.

(C) STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS AND IN BANC REVIEW.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO § 5-106(B) OF THE COURTS ARTICLE.
