Chapter 299 of the Acts of 1999

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1999. [It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development 5-1303.

- (a) The Department may use moneys in the Fund to:
 - (1) Provide financial assistance to eligible applicants; and
- (2) Pay expenses for administrative, actuarial, legal, and technical services for the Fund.
- (b) Subject to the restrictions of this subtitle, the Department may provide financial assistance from the Fund to a business that:
 - (1) Is a small business;
- (2) Has made reasonable efforts to obtain financial assistance on reasonable terms from other sources; and
 - (3) Meets the qualifications required by this subtitle.
- (c) To apply for financial assistance, an applicant shall submit an application to the Department on the form that the Department requires.
 - (d) The application shall include:
 - (1) A detailed business plan, including:
 - (i) An itemization of known and estimated costs;
 - (ii) The total amount of investment required; and
- (iii) The amount of financial assistance requested from the Department;
- (2) The amount of funds available to the applicant without financial assistance from the Department;
- (3) Information relating to the financial status of the applicant, including:
 - (i) A current balance sheet;
 - (ii) A profit and loss statement;
 - (iii) Credit references; and
