- (C) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING.
- (D) (1) "DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS" MEANS THOSE RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND WHO HAVE A PARTIAL OR COMPLETE LOSS OF HEARING.
- (2) "DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS" INCLUDES THE DEAF, THE HARD OF HEARING, AND THE LATE DEAFENED.
- (B) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE MARYLAND ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS.
- (C) (1) "DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS" MEANS THOSE RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND WHO HAVE A PARTIAL OR COMPLETE LOSS OF HEARING.
- (2) "DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS" INCLUDES THE DEAF, THE HARD OF HEARING, AND THE LATE-DEAFENED.
 - (D) "DIRECTOR" MEANS THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE.
- (E) "OFFICE" MEANS THE OFFICE OF THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING. 10–202. 9–2302.
- (A) IN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR THERE IS AN OFFICE OF THE DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING.
 - (B) (1) THE HEAD OF THE OFFICE IS THE DIRECTOR.
- (2) (I) THE DIRECTOR IS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
- (II) THE DIRECTOR SERVES AT THE PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR AND IS RESPONSIBLE DIRECTLY TO THE GOVERNOR.
 - (3) THE DIRECTOR SHALL BE:
 - (I) A DEAF OR HARD OF HEARING PERSON; AND
- (II) KNOWLEDGEABLE AND EXPERIENCED WITH ISSUES AFFECTING DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING INDIVIDUALS.
- (4) The director is entitled to the salary provided in the state budget.
 - (C) (1) THE DIRECTOR OFFICE SHALL:
- (I) ADVISE THE GOVERNOR ON ALL MATTERS ASSIGNED TO THE OFFICE; $\underline{\mathsf{AND}}$
- (II) CARRY OUT THE GOVERNOR'S POLICIES ON THE MATTERS ASSIGNED TO THE OFFICE;
