SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Maryland Advisory Council for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing shall expire as follows:

- (1) five members in 2002;
- (2) five members in 2003; and
- (3) five six members in 2004.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 433 - Local Government Tort Claims Act - Limits on Liability.

This emergency bill clarifies that the monetary limits on the liability of a local government under the Local Government Tort Claims Act apply to claims against local governments when named as defendants.

House Bill 942, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 433.

Local Government Tort Claims Act - Limits on Liability
