- (d) (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, the alcoholic beverages inspectors in Anne Arundel County, HARFORD COUNTY, Montgomery County, and Prince George's County who investigate license violations under Article 2B of the Code may issue citations as provided in subsections (a) and (b) of this section only for the purpose of enforcing this subheading within their respective jurisdictions.
- (2) Before issuing citations under this section, alcoholic beverages inspectors shall successfully complete an appropriate program of training in the proper use of arrest authority and pertinent police procedure as required by the board of license commissioners.
- (3) Alcoholic beverages inspectors may not carry firearms in the performance of their duties.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 442 - Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Stadium Beer and Light Wine License.

This bill authorizes the Harford County Liquor Control Board to issue a stadium beer and light wine (on sale) license to the owner or lessee of a professional baseball stadium for use on the stadium premises.

House Bill 217, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 442.
