- [(h)](I) (K) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, [a person] AN INDIVIDUAL who violates any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:
  - (i) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$500; and
  - (ii) For a second or subsequent offense, a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
- (2) [A person] AN INDIVIDUAL who violates subsection [(g)] (H) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to:
  - (i) For a first offense, a fine not exceeding \$500; and
- (ii) For a second or subsequent offense, a fine of not less than \$500 and not exceeding \$2,000.
