- (a) Subject to subsections (b) and (c) of this section[, the Board may adopt regulations to allow individuals to:
- (1) Provide counseling-under the supervision of a certified professional counselor; or
- (2) Provide marriage and family therapy under the supervision of a certified professional counselor marriage and family therapist]:
- (1) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING WITHOUT CERTIFICATION FOR A LIMITED PERIOD OF TIME:
- (I) IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS WORKING AS A TRAINEE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A CERTIFIED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR, A LICENSED CLINICAL PROFESSIONAL COUNSELOR, OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD; AND
- (II) WHILE FULFILLING THE EXPERIENTIAL REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 17-3A-02(F) OF THIS TITLE.
- (2) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY PRACTICE MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY WITHOUT CERTIFICATION FOR A LIMITED PERIOD OF TIME:
- (I) IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS WORKING AS A TRAINEE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED CLINICAL MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPIST OR ANOTHER HEALTH CARE PROVIDER LICENSED UNDER SUBTITLE 3A OF THIS TITLE AND APPROVED BY THE BOARD TO SUPERVISE CERTIFIED AND LICENSED MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPISTS; AND
- (II) WHILE FULFILLING THE EXPERIENTIAL REQUIREMENTS
 UNDER \$ 17 302.1(3) OR \$ 17 3A 02(E) OF THIS TITLE.
- (b) An individual may be authorized to provide counseling under supervision as provided in subsection (a)(1) of this section if the individual has a master's or doctoral degree in a professional counseling field from an accredited educational institution that is approved by the Board.
- (e) An individual may be authorized to provide marriage and family therapy under supervision as provided in subsection (a)(2) of this section if the individual has a master's or doctoral degree in a marriage and family field or has completed a program of studies judged by the Board to be substantially equivalent in subject matter and extent of training as required under § 17–302(d) of this subtitle.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "License" means a license issued by the Board to practice clinical professional counseling, clinical marriage and family therapy, or clinical alcohol and drug counseling.
