- (I) AN ACT OR CONDITION KNOWINGLY CREATED, PERFORMED, OR MAINTAINED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY THAT CONSTITUTES A LOCAL CODE VIOLATION AND THAT:
- 1. SIGNIFICANTLY AFFECTS OTHER RESIDENTS OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD:
- 2. DIMINISHES THE VALUE OF NEIGHBORING PROPERTY; AND
- $3.\,$  A. IS INJURIOUS TO PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR WELFARE OF NEIGHBORING RESIDENTS; OR
- B. OBSTRUCTS THE REASONABLE USE OF OTHER PROPERTY IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD;
- (II) A PROPERTY WHERE THE TENANT, OWNER, OR OTHER OCCUPANT HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF VIOLATIONS OF ARTICLE 27, § 121 OR § 122 OF THE CODE FOR CONDUCT OCCURRING ON, IN, OR IN RELATION TO THE PROPERTY; OR
- (III) A PROPERTY TO WHICH POLICE OR OTHER LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES HAVE RESPONDED TO COMPLAINTS OR CALLS FOR SERVICE 10 OR MORE TIMES WITHIN ANY 30 DAY PERIOD.
- (B) THIS SECTION ONLY APPLIES TO A NUISANCE LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.
- (C) AN ACTION UNDER § 4 401 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE TO ABATE A NUISANCE MAY BE BROUGHT UNDER THIS SECTION AND § 4-401 OF THE COURTS ARTICLE BY:
  - (1) THE STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;
  - (2) THE COUNTY ATTORNEY FOR ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY:
- (3) A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION WITHIN WHOSE BOUNDARIES THE NUISANCE IS LOCATED, OR
  - (4) THE CITY ATTORNEY FOR THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS.
- (D) (1) A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION PERSON SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION MAY SEEK INJUNCTIVE AND OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ABATEMENT OF A NUISANCE UPON SHOWING:
- (I) THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION HAVE BEEN SATISFIED; AND
  - (II) THE NUISANCE HAS NOT BEEN ABATED.
- (2) (I) AN ACTION MAY NOT BE BROUGHT BY A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION UNDER THIS SECTION BASED ON A NUISANCE UNTIL 60 DAYS AFTER THE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION PLAINTIFF GIVES NOTICE OF THE VIOLATION AND OF THE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION'S PLAINTIFF'S INTENT TO BRING AN ACTION
