

(2) EACH APPLICATION SHALL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

(I) IF AN INDIVIDUAL, THE NAME, RESIDENCE, AND BUSINESS ADDRESS OF THE APPLICANT;

(II) IF A PARTNERSHIP, THE NAME, RESIDENCE, AND BUSINESS ADDRESS OF EACH PARTNER;

(III) IF A DOMESTIC CORPORATION, THE NAME AND BUSINESS ADDRESS OF THE CORPORATION AND THE NAME AND RESIDENCE ADDRESS OF THE PRINCIPAL OFFICER OF THE CORPORATION AND IF A CORPORATION OTHER THAN A DOMESTIC CORPORATION, THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF AN AGENT LOCATED LOCALLY WHO SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO ACCEPT SERVICE OF PROCESS;

(IV) THE NUMBER OF YEARS THE APPLICANT HAS ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF INSTALLING, ALTERING, REPAIRING, OR SERVICING ELEVATORS;

(V) THE APPROXIMATE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS, IF ANY, TO BE EMPLOYED BY THE ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR APPLICANT, AND IF APPLICABLE, SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT THE EMPLOYEES ARE OR WILL BE COVERED BY WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE;

(VI) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE THAT THE APPLICANT IS OR WILL BE COVERED BY GENERAL LIABILITY, PERSONAL INJURY, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE; AND

~~(VII) CRIMINAL RECORD OF CONVICTIONS, IF ANY, AS VERIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, AND~~

~~(VIII) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES.~~

(K) (1) AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION UPON PAYMENT OF AN EXAMINATION FEE TO THE BOARD OR BOARD'S DESIGNEE.

(2) THE BOARD PERIODICALLY SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.

(3) THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT NOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

(4) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE FEE, CONTENT, SCOPE, AND PASSING SCORE FOR EXAMINATIONS GIVEN UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(5) (I) THE BOARD MAY USE A TESTING SERVICE TO ADMINISTER THE EXAMINATIONS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.

(II) IF THE BOARD USES A TESTING SERVICE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE TESTING SERVICE, SUBJECT TO REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE BOARD, MAY:
