- (III) TO PROVIDE FOR A TEMPORARY WAIVER OF CONTINUING EDUCATION UNDER SPECIFIED CIRCUMSTANCES: AND
- (IV) TO SET RECORD KEEPING CRITERIA FOR APPROVED TRAINING PROVIDERS.
- (6) THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF AND ISSUE A RENEWAL CERTIFICATE TO EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- (P) (1) WHENEVER AN EMERGENCY EXISTS IN THE STATE DUE TO DISASTER, ACT OF GOD, OR WORK STOPPAGE AND THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS IN THE STATE HOLDING LICENSES ISSUED BY THE BOARD IS INSUFFICIENT TO COPE WITH THE EMERGENCY, THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR SHALL RESPOND AS NECESSARY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC.
- (2) ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED BY A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR TO HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE COMBINATION OF DOCUMENTED EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION TO PERFORM ELEVATOR WORK WITHOUT DIRECT AND IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION SHALL SEEK AN EMERGENCY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE FROM THE BOARD WITHIN 5 BUSINESS DAYS AFTER BEGINNING WORK REQUIRING A LICENSE.
- $\hbox{ (3) } \quad \hbox{THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE EMERGENCY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSES. }$
- (4) THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE PROOF OF COMPETENCY AS THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE.
- (5) EACH EMERGENCY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE IS VALID FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS FOR PARTICULAR ELEVATORS OR GEOGRAPHICAL AREAS AS THE BOARD DESIGNATES AND ENTITLES THE LICENSEE TO THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF AN ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (6) THE BOARD SHALL RENEW AN EMERGENCY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE DURING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY.
- (7) THE BOARD MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF AN EMERGENCY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSE.
- (Q) (1) A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD WHEN THERE ARE NO LICENSED PERSONNEL AVAILABLE TO PERFORM ELEVATOR WORK.
- (2) THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR MAY REQUEST THE BOARD TO ISSUE TEMPORARY ELEVATOR MECHANIC LICENSES TO INDIVIDUALS CERTIFIED BY THE LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR TO HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE COMBINATION OF DOCUMENTED EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION TO PERFORM ELEVATOR WORK WITHOUT DIRECT AND IMMEDIATE SUPERVISION.
- (3) ANY INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED BY A LICENSED ELEVATOR CONTRACTOR TO HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE COMBINATION OF DOCUMENTED
