SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 9-103 and 9-104 of Article 33 - Election Code of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 9-106 of Article 33 - Election Code of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section 9-104.

SECTION 1. 3. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 33 - Election Code

- (a) [A local board may not use a voting system in an election conducted under this article unless the voting system has been certified in accordance with this subtitle] THE STATE BOARD, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE LOCAL BOARDS, SHALL SELECT AND CERTIFY A VOTING SYSTEM FOR VOTING IN POLLING PLACES AND A VOTING SYSTEM FOR ABSENTEE VOTING.
- (b) [Except as otherwise provided by law or authorized in writing by the State Board, a local board shall either:
- (1) Use a single voting system for both absentee voting and voting in polling places; or
- (2) <u>Use a single voting system for absentee voting and a single different voting system for voting in polling places</u>] THE VOTING SYSTEM SELECTED AND CERTIFIED FOR VOTING IN POLLING PLACES AND THE VOTING SYSTEM SELECTED AND CERTIFIED FOR ABSENTEE VOTING SHALL BE USED IN ALL JURISDICTIONS COUNTIES.
 - (C) THE STATE BOARD SHALL ACQUIRE:
- (1) THE VOTING SYSTEM SELECTED AND CERTIFIED FOR VOTING IN POLLING PLACES; AND
