Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 874 - Disposition of Settlement Proceeds - Frostburg State University and the Washington Redskins.

This bill requires Frostburg State University to deposit proceeds from its \$750,000 settlement with the Washington Redskins directly into the endowment funds managed and maintained by the University System of Maryland. The proceeds must be used exclusively for the benefit of Frostburg State University.

House Bill 1399, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 874.

Senate Bill No. 874

AN ACT concerning

Disposition of Settlement Proceeds - Frostburg State University and the Washington Redskins

FOR the purpose of requiring Frostburg State University to deposit certain proceeds from the settlement of a contract dispute between the University and the Washington Redskins into a certain endowment for the benefit of the University; requiring the University System of Maryland to manage the proceeds for the benefit of the University; making this Act an emergency measure; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the disposition of proceeds from a contract dispute between Frostburg State University and the Washington Redskins.
