

YEAR, TOGETHER WITH SUPPORTING SCHEDULES TO SHOW HOW THE BUDGET IS FINANCED, AND TO PROVIDE FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATIONS.

(II) THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SHALL FORWARD THE PROPOSED OPERATING BUDGET TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT FOR CONSIDERATION.

(3) THE STATE BUDGET, SUBJECT TO ANNUAL REVIEW BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SHALL PROVIDE AN APPROPRIATION IN THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR OF AT LEAST \$200,000 FOR SUPPORT OF THE COUNCIL.

(B) (1) THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL'S ACTIVITIES MAY BE FINANCED COOPERATIVELY BY THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND CAROLINE, DORCHESTER, AND TALBOT COUNTIES.

(2) THE COUNCIL MAY RECEIVE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FROM OTHER PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SOURCES.

(3) THE GOVERNING BODIES OF CAROLINE, DORCHESTER, AND TALBOT COUNTIES ANNUALLY SHALL APPROPRIATE AT LEAST \$10,000 EACH FOR THE USE OF THE COUNCIL TO FOSTER COOPERATIVE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT IN THE REGION.

(4) THE GOVERNING BODIES OF CAROLINE, DORCHESTER, AND TALBOT COUNTIES MAY APPROPRIATE ANY OTHER MONEYS THAT ARE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE FOR THE COUNCIL.

(5) OTHER POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICTS MAY APPROPRIATE MONEY THAT IS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE FOR THE COUNCIL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to confer any land use regulation or zoning authority to the Mid-Shore Regional Council.

SECTION ~~2.~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
