- (g) If the abandoned vessel is in such a condition of disrepair that the Department cannot remove the vessel intact, the Department may dispose of the vessel in whatever manner is reasonable without providing the notice required under subsections (c) through (e) of this section.
- (h) The Department may delegate the Department's authority to remove and dispose of abandoned vessels under this section to any local jurisdiction that consents to the delegation.

- (a) The owner or operator of a PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD or the owner's or operator's agent may have a vessel removed from the PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD by a private person if the vessel has remained on the [marina] premises without permission for more than 48 hours and the owner, operator, or agent has placed in conspicuous locations signs that:
- (1) State that vessels left at the PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD without permission for more than 48 hours are subject to removal at the vessel owner's expense;
 - (2) State the location to which the vessel will be removed:
- (3) State that the vessel-owner will be responsible for all costs associated with the removal and storage of the vessel; and
- (4) Provide the telephone number of a person who can be contacted to arrange for the reclaiming of the vessel by its owner or the owner's agent.
- (b) A vessel may not be removed from a PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD to a location that is more than 30 miles from the marina.
- (e) The owner or operator of a PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD, or the agent of the owner or operator, on finding a vessel left at the PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina, DOCK, OR BOATYARD without permission, shall make a reasonable attempt to notify the vessel owner or the vessel owner's agent of the intended removal of the vessel before the vessel may be removed under this section.
- (d) A person who removes the vessel from a [marina] PUBLIC OR PRIVATE MARINA, DOCK, OR BOATYARD:
- (1) Shall notify the vessel owner or the vessel owner's agent at the earliest possible time after removing the vessel from the PUBLIC OR PRIVATE marina; DOCK, OR BOATYARD and shall provide the following information:
- (i) A description of the vessel including the vessel's certificate of boat number:
 - (ii) The date and time the vessel was removed;
 - (iii) The reason the vessel was removed; and
 - (iv) The locations from which and to which the vessel was moved;
