11-917. SAME — STATUS; INVESTMENTS; CONSTRUCTION.

(A) STATUS.

(1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL CONTINUING, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

(2) THE TREASURER SHALL SEPARATELY HOLD AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

(3) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL MAKE PAYMENTS FROM THE FUND THAT THE BOARD APPROVES.

(B) INVESTMENTS.

(1) THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE FUNDS.

(2) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND.

(C) CONSTRUCTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE FUND FROM RECEIVING MONEY FROM ANY SOURCE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, §§ 854(j)(2), (3), (4), (5), and (8) and 830(e)(5).

In subsection (c) of this section, the word "money" is substituted for the former reference to "funds" to avoid confusion with the defined term "Fund". See § 11-910 of this subtitle. Also the former reference to money from any "other" source is deleted because a source of money is not identified in this section.

11-918. SAME — AUDIT; DISBURSEMENTS.

(A) AUDIT.

THE FUND IS SUBJECT TO AN AUDIT BY THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AUDITS UNDER § 2-1220 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

(B) DISBURSEMENTS.

DISBURSEMENTS FROM THE FUND SHALL SUPPLEMENT AND MAY NOT BE A SUBSTITUTE FOR ANY STATE, LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR OTHER FUNDS EXISTING ON JULY 1, 1991, FOR ASSISTANCE TO CRIME VICTIMS OR WITNESSES.
