AN ACT concerning

~~Vehicles — Certificates of Title — Temporary Registration~~**Vehicle Laws — Titling and Registration — Time Period Extensions**

FOR the purpose of ~~altering the number of days after the date of delivery of certain vehicles within which a transferring dealer is required to send to the Motor Vehicle Administration certain documents, taxes, and fees required for titling the vehicle; altering the number of days after the date of delivery of certain vehicles within which a transferring dealer is required to deliver the certificate of title to the transferee or send to the Motor Vehicle Administration certain documents, taxes, and fees required for titling the vehicle; altering the number of days after issuance of a temporary plate after which the temporary registration of a vehicle expires; and generally relating to certificates of title and temporary registration of vehicles~~ extending the period after the delivery of certain vehicles transferred from a licensed dealer to a person other than a licensed dealer during which the transferring dealer must send certain titling documents, taxes, and fees to the Motor Vehicle Administration; extending the period during which a dealer who transfers certain vehicles to be registered and titled in Maryland must deliver a certificate of title to the transferee or send certain titling documents, taxes, and fees to the Administration; extending the period during which a dealer who transfers a vehicle that is not to be titled and registered in Maryland must deliver a certificate of title to the transferee; extending the period during which a temporary vehicle registration remains valid under certain circumstances; and generally relating to extending certain time periods concerning vehicle titling and registration.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article — Transportation

13-113.

(a) If the transferee of a vehicle is a licensed dealer who holds the vehicle for sale, the dealer shall within 20 days of the date of the transfer to the dealer of the vehicle, obtain the certificate of title of the vehicle, which shall contain an assignment and warranty of title executed by the former owner.
