(A) A PERSON WHO FINDS OR GAINS POSSESSION OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR IDENTIFICATION BADGE REQUIRED UNDER § 538 OF THIS SUBHEADING SHALL SURRENDER IMMEDIATELY THE IDENTIFICATION CARD OR IDENTIFICATION BADGE TO THE NEAREST POLICE STATION.

(B) IN ORDER TO ENTER A PLACE OR ESTABLISHMENT IN WHICH A PERSON IS REQUIRED TO HAVE AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR IDENTIFICATION BADGE UNDER § 538 OF THIS SUBHEADING, A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY:

(1) MAKE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR IDENTIFICATION BADGE; OR

(2) ASSIST ANOTHER IN THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF AN IDENTIFICATION CARD OR IDENTIFICATION BADGE.

(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH.

THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT IMPAIR, CURTAIL, OR DESTROY THE RIGHTS OF EMPLOYEES AND THEIR REPRESENTATIVES TO:

(1) SELF-ORGANIZATION;

(2) FORM, JOIN, OR ASSIST LABOR ORGANIZATIONS;

(3) BARGAIN COLLECTIVELY THROUGH REPRESENTATIVES OF THEIR OWN CHOOSING; AND

(4) STRIKE, PICKET, OR ENGAGE IN CONCERTED ACTIVITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING OR OTHER MUTUAL AID OR PROTECTION.

IF CONDUCT PROHIBITED BY THIS SUBHEADING IS ALSO UNLAWFUL UNDER ANOTHER LAW, A PERSON MAY BE CONVICTED FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS SUBHEADING ~~OR~~ AND THE OTHER LAW.

577.

(a) (1) A person may not enter or trespass on any [private] property which in a conspicuous manner is posted against trespassers by:

(i) Signs where they may reasonably be seen; or

(ii) Identifying paint marks that conform with regulations adopted by the Department of Natural Resources and are made on trees or posts at each road entrance and adjacent to public roadways, public waterways, and any other land adjoining the property.
