

In subsection (b)(8) of this section, the reference to the "arrest" of a suspect is substituted for the former reference to the "apprehension" of a suspect for clarity.

In subsection (b)(10) of this section, the former specific reference to each proceeding "at hearing, trial, or appellate level" is deleted in light of the comprehensive reference to "each" proceeding.

In subsection (b)(13) of this section, the former reference to an "individual [who] is involved as a crime victim or witness" is deleted as implicit in the reference to a "person".

In subsection (b)(14) and (16) of this section, the references to "criminal" are substituted for the former references to "offender" to conform to the terminology used throughout this article.

In subsection (c)(1) of this section, the reference to units that are involved "with carrying out the guidelines" is added to state expressly what formerly was only implied.

In subsection (c)(2) of this section, the former reference to "the inmates employed by" State Use Industries is deleted as implicit in the reference to "State Use Industries".

Throughout this section, the references to a "unit" are substituted for the former references to an "agency" for consistency with other revised articles of the Code. See General Revisor's Note to article.
