

(B) FAILURE OF AGENT TO APPEAR

IF AN AGENT DOES NOT APPEAR WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE TIME OF THE APPREHENSION, THE FUGITIVE MAY BE DISCHARGED.

(C) DEMANDING STATE TO PAY COSTS.

ALL COSTS AND EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE APPREHENDING, SECURING, MAINTAINING, AND TRANSMITTING THE FUGITIVE TO THE STATE MAKING THE DEMAND FOR THE FUGITIVE SHALL BE PAID BY THE DEMANDING STATE.

(D) AUTHORITY OF AGENT.

ANY AGENT SO APPOINTED WHO RECEIVES THE FUGITIVE INTO CUSTODY SHALL BE EMPOWERED TO TRANSMIT THE FUGITIVE TO THE STATE FROM WHICH THE FUGITIVE HAS FLED.

(E) RECIPROCAL POWER.

ON APPLICATION OF ANY PERSON INTERESTED, THE GOVERNOR MAY DEMAND THE RETURN TO THIS STATE OF ANY FUGITIVE WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF THIS SUBTITLE.
