8-509. LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO NOTIFY BOARD OF COMPLAINTS.

(A) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" INCLUDES:

- (1) A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY;
- (2) A SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
- (3) A STATE'S ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; AND
- (4) THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

(B) IN GENERAL.

A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT RECEIVES A COMPLAINT OF DEATH OR BODILY HARM ALLEGEDLY CAUSED BY A NURSE WHO HOLDS A LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD OF THE COMPLAINT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Chapter 10, Acts of 2001, which enacted the Criminal Procedure Article, also enacted this section, which is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 27, § 593C.

In subsection (a) of this section, the former statement that a law enforcement agency "means a State, county, or municipal police department, bureau, or agency" is deleted in light of subsection (a)(1) of this section, which "includes" the same entities.

In subsection (b) of this section, the reference to a nurse who "holds a license or certificate under this title" is substituted for the former reference to a nurse who "is licensed or certified in accordance with Title 8 of the Health Occupations Article" to reflect the recodification of this provision.
