A CHARTER RESOLUTION

OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK,
MARYLAND, AMENDING ARTICLE X, "FINANCE AND TAXATION, § C10-11,"
"PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION, RATES, LEVY AND COLLECTIONS;
ADMISSIONS AND AMUSEMENT TAX" OF THE CITY CHARTER TO DELETE
SUBSECTION C, THEREBY ELIMINATING THE MAXIMUM CAP ON THE TAX
RATE, THE MAXIMUM INCREMENTAL TAX RATE INCREASE LIMIT, AND
ANY REQUIREMENT THAT A MAXIMUM RATE CHANGE BE TAKEN TO
AUTOMATIC REFERENDUM, AND RENUMBERING THE REMAINING
SECTIONS.

Charter Amendment Resolution 00-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF COTTAGE CITY, MARYLAND, adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 14 of Article 23A, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, as amended), to amend the Charter of the said Town, said Charter being Subtitle 17 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1963 Edition, as amended), which article contains in whole or in part, the Charter of the Town of Cottage City, by amending Section 8 of said Charter so that the Commissioners may raise their annual salary from Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) to One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) and make it effective immediately.
