Proclamation

I, Edward C. Athey, Mayor of the City of Cumberland, Maryland, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Maryland, and as Chief Executive Officer of said City, do hereby proclaim in accordance with Subsection (C) of Section 16 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition) that the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Cumberland, Maryland, that repeals Section 226 which forbids fluoridation of the municipal water supply for preventive health purposes and which amendment becomes part of the Charter.

Resolution No. 122

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, Maryland, adopted pursuant to the authority contained in Article 11–E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, (1957 Edition, as supplemented and amended), entitled “Municipal Corporations”, subtitled “Home Rule”, entitled “A Resolution to Amend the Charter of the City of Cumberland (1991 Edition, as amended) being Article 1A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, repealing Section 229 of the Charter, thereby abolishing the Municipal Parking Authority and by repealing and re-enacting with Amendments, Section 230, for the purpose of clarifying certain matters having to do with the powers, duties and functions of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland with respect to parking”.
