A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNCIL, BY ORDINANCE, TO ESTABLISH A DATE OR DATES OTHER THAN JULY FIRST AS THE DATE ON WHICH PROPERTY TAXES ARE DUE AND PAYABLE AND TO PROVIDE THAT TAXES WILL BE CONSIDERED OVERDUE AND IN ARREARS ON A DATE OR DATES SPECIFIED BY THE COUNCIL.

Charter Amendment No. 01-9

A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO MODIFY THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE COUNCIL MEET AT LEAST ONCE EACH MONTH TO PERMIT THE COUNCIL TO OMIT A MEETING IN ONE MONTH OF EACH CALENDAR YEAR; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COUNCIL MAY NOT OMIT MEETING DURING TWO CONSECUTIVE MONTHS; AND TO REQUIRE THAT THE COUNCIL PROVIDE NOTICE OF ITS INTENTION TO OMIT A MONTHLY MEETING AT LEAST ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE MEETING PRECEDING THE MEETING TO BE OMITTED.

Charter Amendment No. 01-10

A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO PERMIT THE COUNCIL TO SPECIFY A DATE ON WHICH A NON-EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT, PROVIDED SUCH DATE SHALL BE AT LEAST TWENTY-ONE CALENDAR DAYS FOLLOWING PASSAGE BY THE COUNCIL AND TO PROVIDE THAT IN THE ABSENCE OF A SPECIFIED DATE, ORDINANCES, OTHER THAN EMERGENCY ORDINANCES, SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE AT THE EXPIRATION OF TWENTY CALENDAR DAYS FOLLOWING PASSAGE BY THE COUNCIL.
