

(f) (1) For purposes of this subsection, §§ 4-113, 4-114, 27-501, and 27-505 of this article apply to nonprofit health service plans and health maintenance organizations.

(2) The Commissioner may issue an order under §§ 4-113, 4-114, 27-501, and 27-505 of this article if the Commissioner finds a violation of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 13

(Senate Bill 9)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership - World War II Veteran

FOR the purpose of requiring that the at-large member of the Maryland Veterans Commission be a veteran of World War II.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - State Government

Section 9-907(a)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

9-907.

(a) (1) The Commission consists of the following 29 members:

(i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland Veterans' Home Commission; and

(ii) 28 members appointed by the Governor.

(2) Of the 28 appointed members:

(i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in the State;

(ii) 1 shall be A VETERAN OF WORLD WAR II, appointed from the State at large;
