AN ACT concerning:

Baltimore County Code, 1998 - Eleventh Enactment

FOR the purpose of enacting the Baltimore County Code, 1998 and adding one article to the Baltimore County Code, to be designated and known as "Article 21. Permits, Licenses, and Business Regulation", to revise, restate, and recodify the laws of the County relating and pertaining to the permitting, licensing, and business regulation law of the county; repealing certain obsolete provisions; repealing certain provisions pre-empted by State law; repealing certain provisions that have been declared illegal in a court decision; defining certain terms; providing for the construction and application of this Act; providing for the continuity of terms of certain officials, the status of certain transactions and employees, rights, titles, and interests, licenses, registrations, certifications, and permits; providing for a contingent effective date of this Act; and generally relating to the laws of the County.
