AN ACT granting a tax credit against the Howard County property tax imposed on certain historic structures and buildings located in certain historic districts, if an automatic fire protection sprinkler system is installed therein; establishing procedures for the implementation of this Act; defining certain terms; and providing for the application of this Act.

AN ACT adopting a certain Chapter of the Code of Maryland Regulations, as amended from time to time, as the regulations for Howard County governing the operation of public swimming pools and spas; adopting certain local amendments to the regulations; and generally relating to the regulation of public swimming pools and spas in Howard County.

Bill No. 12-2000

AN ACT requiring the registration of businesses that install and monitor alarms in Howard County; requiring alarm systems in Howard County to be registered; providing that a request for dispatch of police may only be made upon activation of an alarm if the alarm is registered; establishing standards for the installation, operation, and maintenance of alarm systems; establishing procedures for the monitoring of alarm systems; establishing penalties for violations of this Act; providing for the suspension of a registration under certain circumstances; establishing appeal procedures; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the regulation of alarm systems.

Bill No. 13-2000

AN ACT providing that the water and sewer service charges imposed by Howard County are composed of a volumetric usage charge and an account user service charge; providing that the water service charge includes a seasonal volumetric component; and altering the computation of water and sewer service charges.
