

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 22

(Senate Bill 110)

AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Winding Brook Special Taxing District

FOR the purpose of establishing the Winding Brook Special Taxing District in Cecil County for the purpose of paying the costs of certain services within the district; providing that the Board of County Commissioners for Cecil County constitutes the District Board for the purposes of administering the district; requiring the Board of County Commissioners to levy an annual tax on property in the district sufficient to pay the costs of trash collection, mowing of common areas, and general maintenance of the district; requiring that the special district tax be collected in the same manner as other taxes in the County and be paid to the County Treasurer; and generally relating to the Winding Brook Special Taxing District in Cecil County.

Section 75-13 through 75-16 to be under the new article "Article IV. Winding Brook"

Article 8 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
