

Montgomery County - Rehabilitation Opportunities Loan of 2000.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 310 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2000

Section 1(3)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 310 of the Acts of 2000

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of Rehabilitation Opportunities, Inc. (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a facility located in [Clarksburg,] Montgomery County, Maryland, for use in helping developmentally disabled adults enter the workforce.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
